supervision in line with the BACP, this requires a session of supervision for 1 ½ hours per session for every 8 clients you see, whilst studying this does include any clients that do not attend within the 8 hours. By the second year of study you will be seeing 4 clients a week to complete the course within the time frame available. This means you will need to attend supervision every second week. Many supervisors charge up to £60 per session, if you are attending every other week this will be a cost to yourself of £120 every 4 weeks. Many learners attend roughly 15 sessions of supervision whilst studying, this would equal a cost of £900. As with personal therapy this does depend on what the supervisor charges.	 Further information: If you do not use all of your funding you cannot use it for anything else. For instance, if your personal therapist charges £25 per hour – leaving £10 per session on your loan – this cannot be used for extra sessions or further supervision. Any remaining funds are left on your account and when you begin to repay the loan you only pay back what you have used from the loan. The loan amount is held and distributed by the college, your personal therapists and supervisor must be able to invoice the college directly for payment.
